The cost of entry to this exhibition is £10.00, payable at the entrance. There is no admission charged for the permanent collections of the Ashmolean, and you would be welcome to join us just to see these, or enjoy a day in Oxford. There are two eating places in the Ashmolean (see [www.ashmolean.org/cafe-and-restaurant](http://www.ashmolean.org/cafe-and-restaurant)) and it is possible to book a table in the restaurant; but we leave this to you!
